## DEMOLITION DERBY - DRIVERS RULES

1. Each driver must fill out an entry form.
2. Both driver and both pit crew members must go immediately to the registration table and sign a waiver of liability and indemnity agreement before entering any restricted area. You will then receive your armbands for admittance. (**Armbands will be issued to Driver and 2 pit crew only-no exceptions**)
3. Only one driver and two pit crew members will be allowed in the pit area or on the track. Armband must be displayed at all times. Pits closed to public access at 6:00 PM.
4. Drivers must be at least 18 years of age and no one under 18 years old will be allowed in the restricted areas. You may have to show a valid I.D. or driver's license for proof.
5. Only two vehicles will be allowed in the pit area, the vehicle to be entered and the transport vehicle. All others must park in the regular fairground parking area.
6. The use of mind-altering drugs or intoxicating beverages will disqualify the vehicle, you will be asked to leave and will forfeit your registration fee.
7. There will be a mandatory drivers meeting before the derby at 6:30 PM. Location will be announced.
8. Flags for derby use are as follows:  
Green-Go      Red-Stop      Black-Disqualified      Checkered-Winner
9. All vehicles must stop at the sound of the horn or red flag.
10. Drivers may maneuver forward and backwards. No deliberate head-on-collisions or ramming the driver's door. This can lead to disqualification. The judges will set a TIME LIMIT. If a driver does not hit a live car within the time limit, this will be considered as possuming and you will be disqualified.
11. Do not leave a vehicle during a heat unless told by an official to do so.
12. If your vehicle is disabled you must break your flag off.
13. The official reserves the right to set the number of heats as well as the number of vehicles per heat. No more than two vehicles per heat per sponsored entry.
14. ADDITIONAL SAFETY REGULATIONS MAY BE IMPOSED depending on track.
15. DECISIONS MADE BY OFFICIALS ARE FINAL.

**THERE WILL BE A NON REFUNDABLE PRE-REGISTRATION ENTRY FEE IS \$50.00 DUE BY SEPTEMBER 3rd, 2008. REGISTRATION AFTER SEPTEMBER 3rd WILL BE \$75.00 (NO EXCEPTIONS)**

## DEMOLITION DERBY

### VEHICLE AND SAFETY REGULATIONS

1. All vehicles must be stock. No modification allowed except where noted. No rear engine cars, vans, pickups, hearses, or jeeps.
2. Safety belts and helmets are required and must be used. Eye Safety Glasses must be used if the windshield is removed.
3. All glass and chrome trim must be removed and/or anything that may become imbedded in the track. This includes wheel weights and front-end noses composed of fiberglass. Cars must also be cleaned out inside including the trunk. Do not leave broken glass in car.  
NOTE: WINDSHIELD MAY BE LEFT IN PLACE.
4. Fuel cell must be located inside car and have a fire shield if you are not using an approved outboard container. Quick release connectors or shut off valve is required within reach of the driver. FUEL CELLS ARE TO BE SECURED IN THE REAR SEAT AREA OF VEHICLE.
5. NO REINFORCEMENTS OF ANY KIND WILL BE ALLOWED. Only exception will be the driver side door. Trailer hitches or any type of stiffening device are considered reinforcement. You may WELD rear ends or differentials to create a positive traction rear end. Welding of bumper shocks is considered reinforcement. Maximum bumper height is 24 inches from the ground to center of bumper. Bumper must be present before each heat.
6. Doors should be welded shut or chained shut. If driver door is welded shut vertical seam only. If driver door opens during event, vehicle is disqualified. Do not weld hood or trunk lids, use chains at no more than 4 points. Hood and trunk must be open for inspection.
7. A minimum 12 x 12 inch hole must be cut over the breather in case of fire. The breather cover must also be in place.
8. Battery may be located in the passenger compartment provided that the battery is in a plastic battery box. The battery MUST be firmly secured or tied down.
9. Radiators must remain in their original position.
10. Vehicles must have brakes before beginning of heat.
11. Exhaust pipes may be run through the hood, provided that the windshield is in place and the pipes extend at least 18 inches through the hood. Standard exhaust system may be removed or cut off just behind driver seat.
12. Any 2-4 ply "P" METRIC TYPE TIRE, PASSENGER TIRES ONLY MAY BE USED. NO LIGHT TRUCK OR MUD GRIP TIRES ACCEPTED. TIRES MUST BE FILLED WITH AIR ONLY. WE WILL BE SPOT CHECKING!
13. Cars may be decorated in any manner as long as it is in good taste. The driver door must be painted white for assigned derby number to be applied. **Numbers are non-negotiable on the day of the derby.** Pre-registered vehicles will get first choice on numbers.
14. Illegal items escaping detection during inspection could lead to disqualification if later discovered.

15. It is strongly recommended that all vehicles be equipped with a fire extinguisher within easy reach for your own protection.

**DEMOLITION DERBY - “FUN RUN”**

All Vehicles that did not place in the previous heats and were still running during that heat will be eligible for the Fun Run. It will be held before the Main Event Heat and the Qualifying Winner of the Fun Run will be eligible for the Main Event Heat.
